ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. **Band competition** will be part of the festival entertainment, times to be announced, at the pub tent! Please no tuning inside the gates.

3. **Solo Check-in Time:** We are trying to get the Competitor gate open at 7 a.m. You will be notified via email of actual time that gates open. Solo start times are subject to change.

PLEASE NOTE: The competitor's gate will NOT sell passes! Each soloist will be mailed ONE pass. Band members will obtain their passes prior to the festival from their band. If you have friends and family that want to come with you, they must buy a ticket ahead of time online. The main gate, which will sell tickets, does not open until much later. Please respect the festival!

Band information:

- The Irish Festival will assign areas for each band to set up tents, **INSIDE THE GROUNDS** this year (yippee!). Bands may not set up tents outside of these areas. Information will be included in confirmation. Tents can be set up the evening before.
- There will be no massed bands.
- Probably prize money; definitely no travel money.

NO ALCOHOL allowed on site, per agreement with Colorado Irish Festival. Alcohol and food will be available at the games. Please no BBQ's, huge food layouts or big coolers! Keep it discreet and to a minimum.
